Report on Traffic Awareness Camp

Date: August 27, 2019

Introduction:

On August 27th 2019, students of the Innovative college of pharmacy organized a Traffic Awareness Camp aimed at educating the public about road safety and responsible driving practices. Objectives:

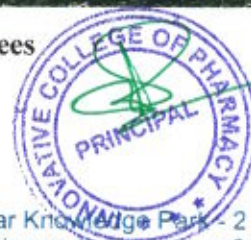

Outcomes: The visit to the orphanage proved to be a fulfilling and enriching experience for both the students and the children. Some notable outcomes include:

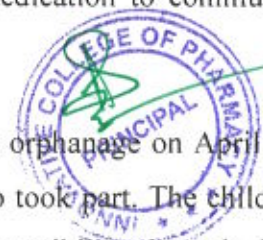
1. Friendship and Bonding: The students and the kids developed deep bonds that promoted a feeling of camaraderie and friendship.

Blood Donation Camp at Innovative college of pharmacy

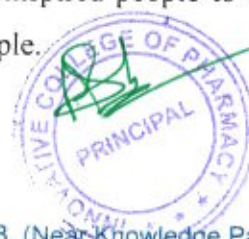
